It is interesting to know that the development of Sufi thought and practices have been influenced, directly and indirectly, by both Upanishadic and Buddhist philosophy.

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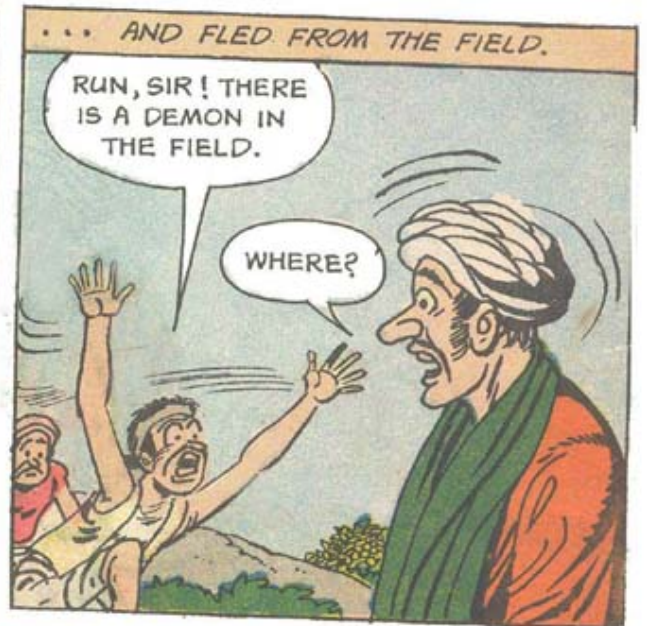
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THE GREEN DEMON

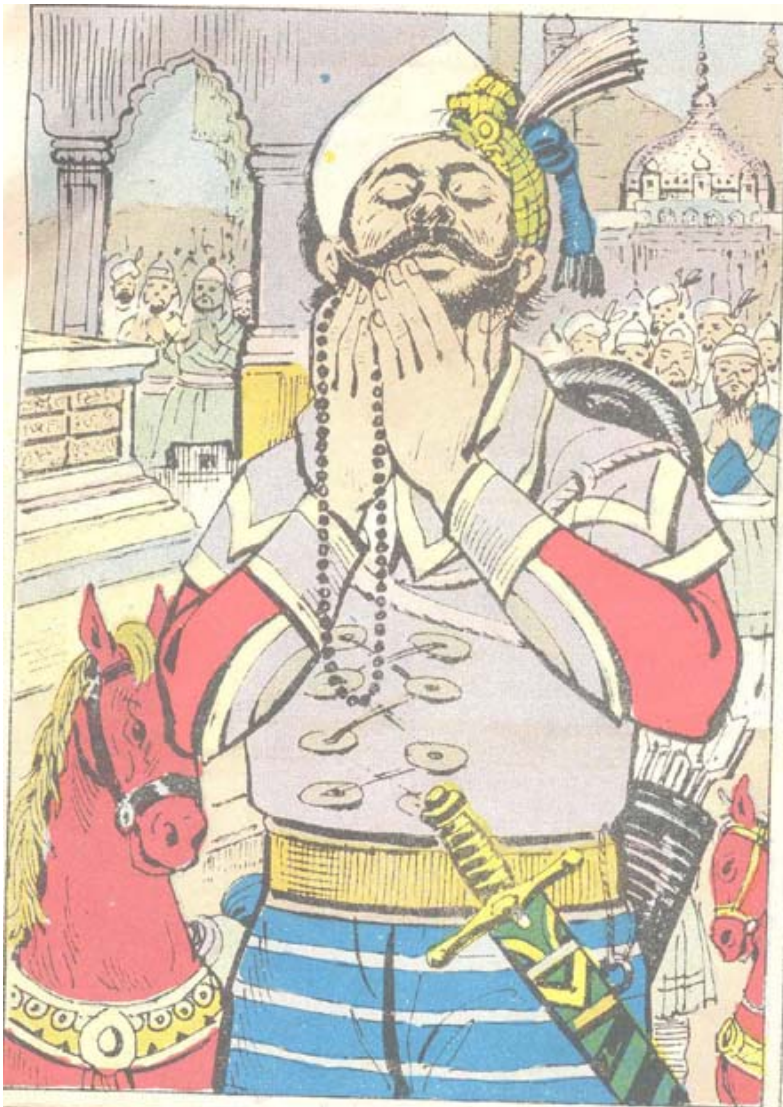
SUFI SAINTS OF INDIA

"BY WHOM?"

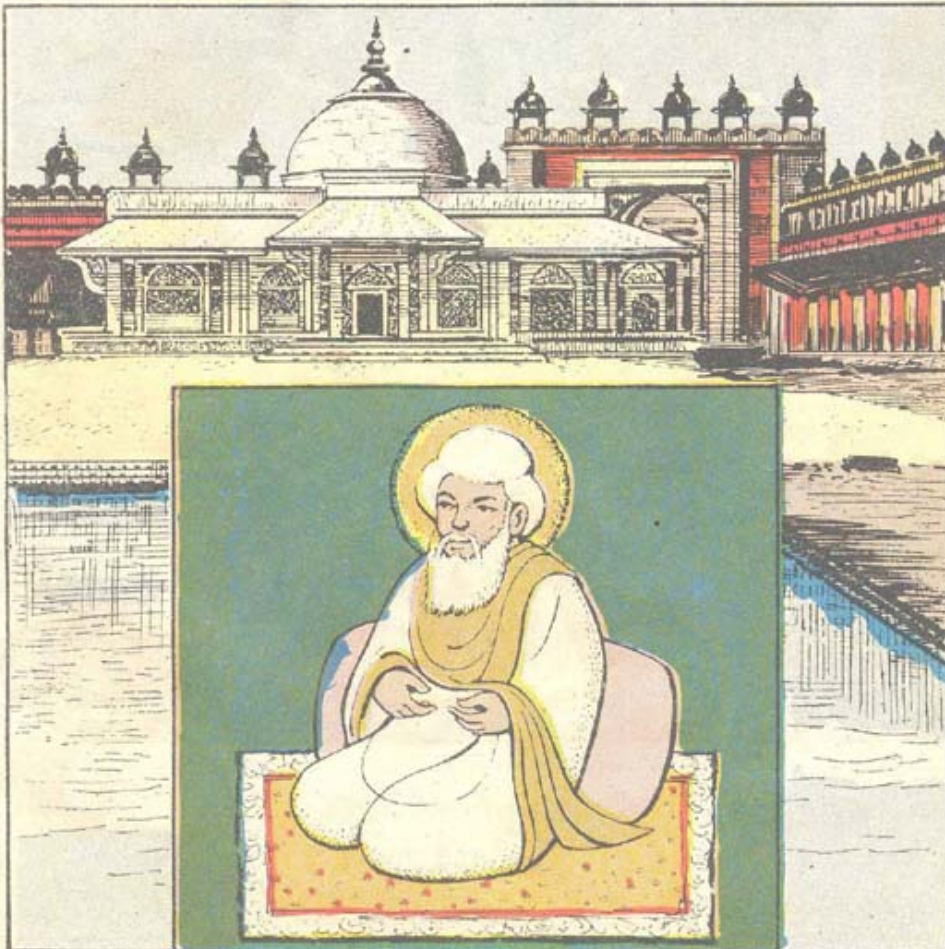
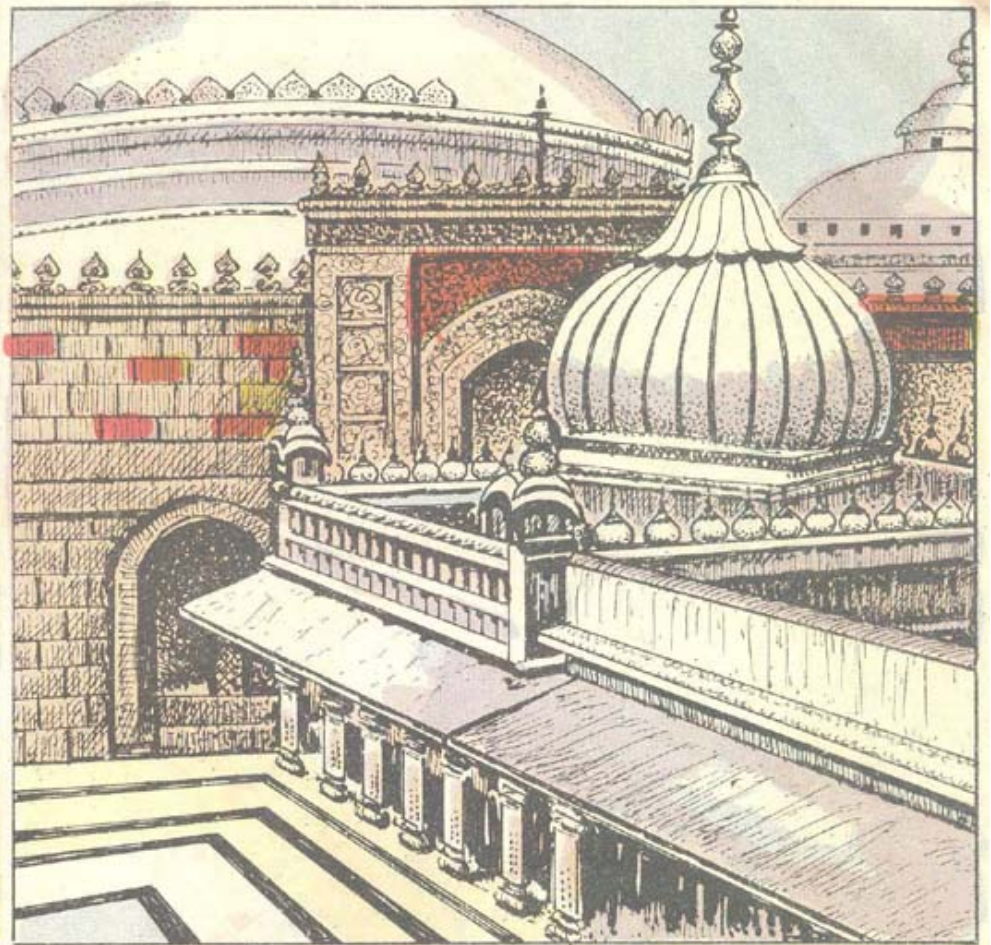
A VOICE ANSWERED: "BABA FARID, THE KING OF KINGS."
