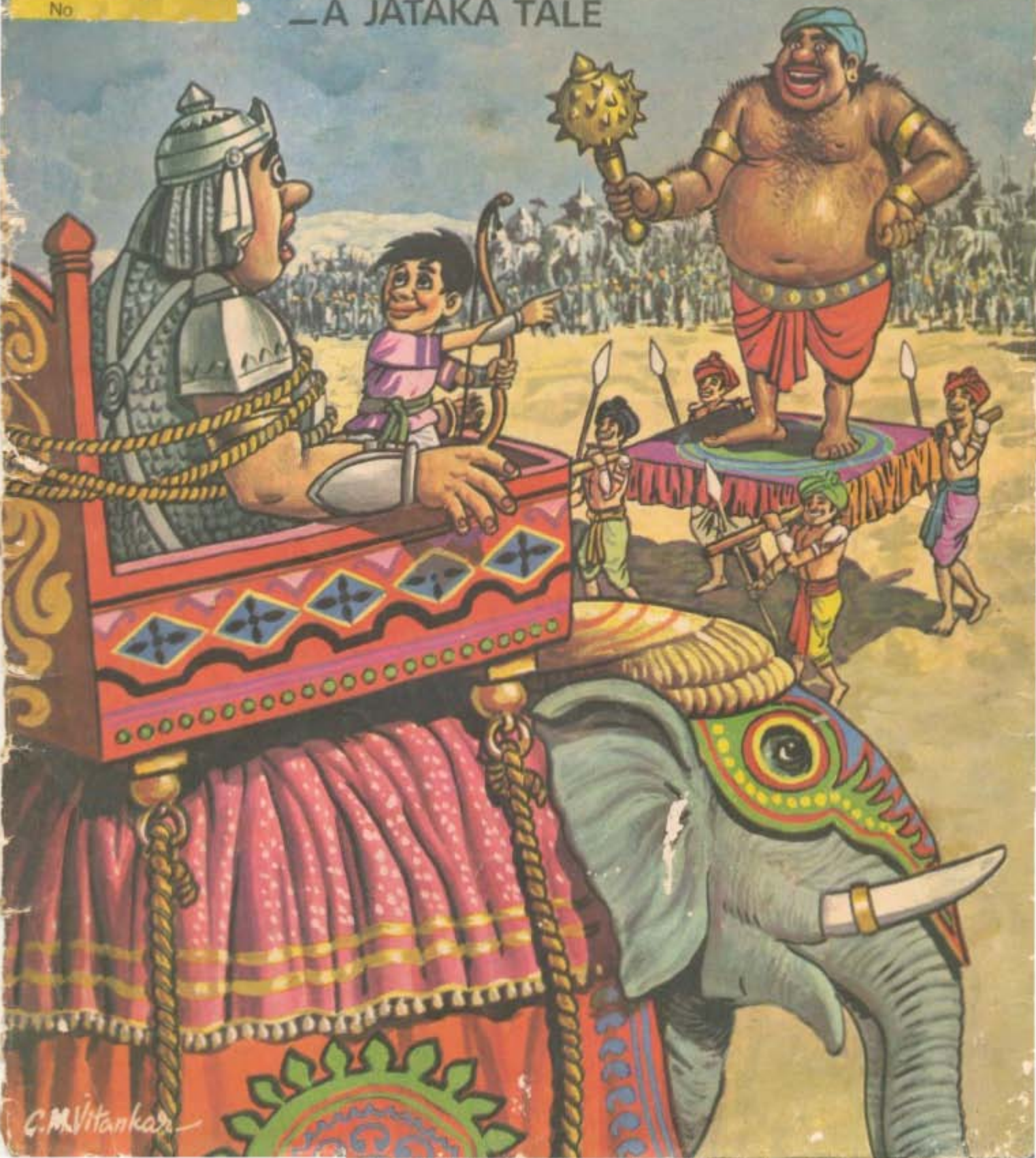

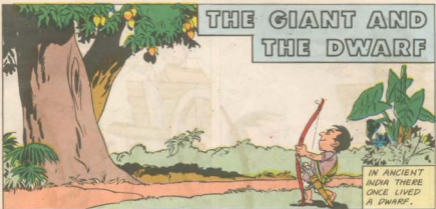

COMICAL THOUGH HE LOOKED, HE WAS EXCEEDINGLY CLEVER. AND HE HAD ONE GREAT TALENT.



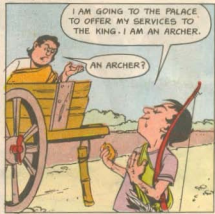
HE WAS AN EXCELLENT ARCHER AND PEOPLE CALLED HIM LITTLE BOWMAN.



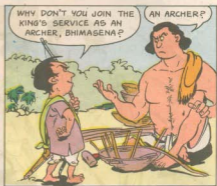
HEY, LOOK AT THAT LITTLE FELLOW!

YOU MAY GO IN.

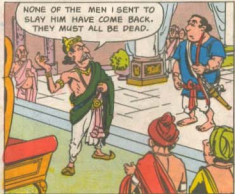


THE KING WAS IMPRESSED BY BHIMASENA'S SIZE.

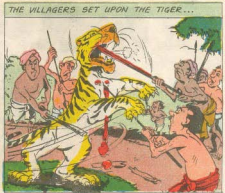

THEY'VE KILLED HIM. GOOD! NOW FOR THE SECOND PART OF THE PLAN.

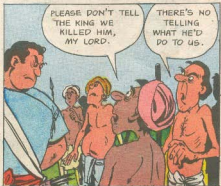
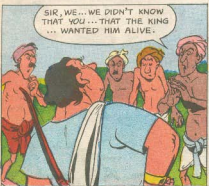
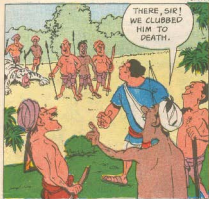

BHIMASENA BECAME EVEN MORE POPULAR. SEVERAL FEASTS WERE GIVEN IN HIS HONOUR.

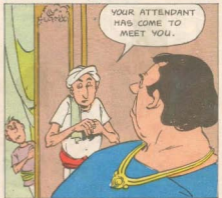
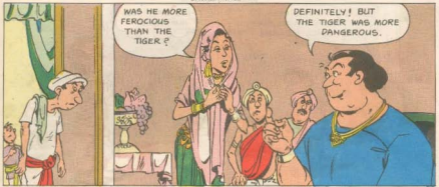


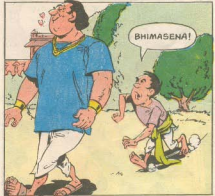
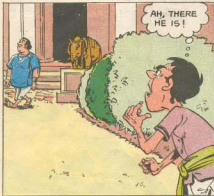

DO YOU SEE WHAT A GREAT MAN I'VE BECOME?

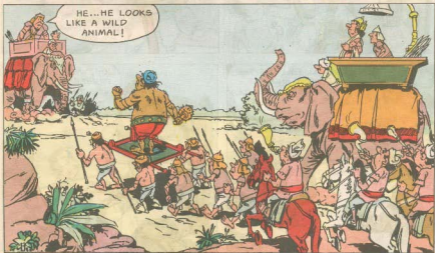
